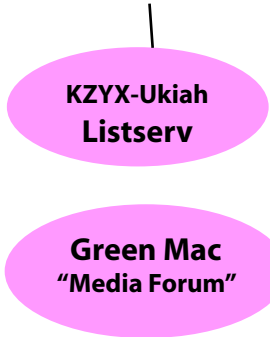
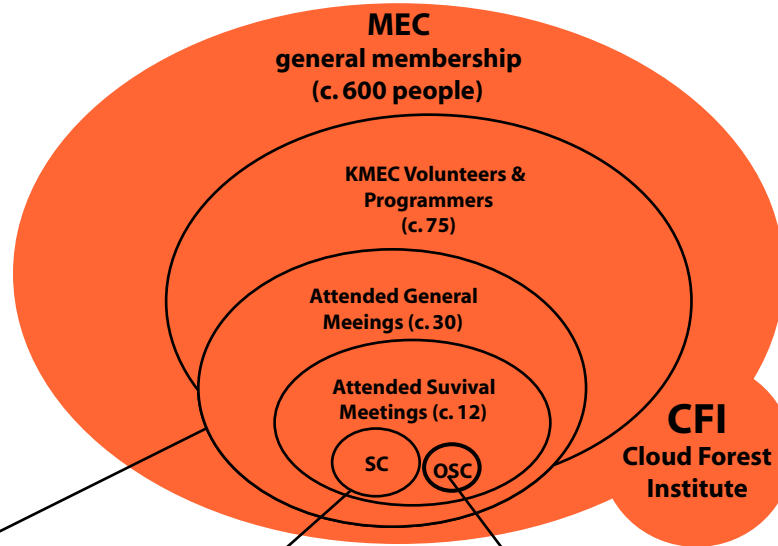


# MEC/KMEC INTERNAL ORGANIZATION

**First General Meeting**  
 First General Meeting was called by Matt James(KMEC programmer). 25 people attended. It was agreed: 1) the restructuring process would be transparent and democratic. 2) A "Survival Committee." was established with 10 volunteers.

**Survival Committee**  
 A group of 9 volunteers met. Due to a mix-up they met at the MEC instead of the UBC. They included: Steve Scalmanini, Govinda Dalton, King Collins, Polly, Simka Leeya Thompson, Molly McCalla, Beth Bosk and Joe Toschi.

**Official Survival Committee**  
 A group of 4 selected themselves (on the basis that they had met in the right place) to become the "Official Survival Committee." Their meetings are closed and they themselves will determine who else may be a member. Since then they selected Steve Scalmanini to join them. Scalmanini accepted the position, although he says he objected (at first!). Some volunteers objected to this process as bureaucratic and counter to the interests of the MEC and the community. K.
